

# Disobey CTF survival guide

## Be safe

- If you connect devices to Disobey networks they might get compromised.
- Avoid bringing networked devices with sensitive information to the party place
- Disable Wifi and Bluetooth if when not in use

## How to participate

- Bring a laptop that does not have any sensitive information on it (Linux might be useful).
- Connect to the game network. At least 1000BASE-T will be available, at this point we cannot promise WiFi access.
- Register a team, solve challenges, submit flags, get points
- If in doubt, ask.

## Rules

- Please try to limit your team size to six persons
- Each challenge has a scoring baseline based on the difficulty. The more teams solve the challenge, the less points the solvers get. Wrong answers might give you negative points.
- Attacks allowed **only** to following domains or IP addresses (unless **explicitly** stated otherwise in the challenge):
  - 172.31.0.0/16 (excluding 172.31.0.2 and 172.31.0.3)
- Fair play. Don't alter the challenges or mistreat other players. Even though it's a competition, the point is to have fun.
